Marc Abramowicz, MD PhD, is a Professor of Medical Genetics, Medical School, Université Libre de Bruxelles (ULB). He is the Director of the integrated Center of Human Genetics of the ULB, and heads the department of medical genetics of university hospital Erasme, Brussels.

After obtaining his MD degree, he specialized in internal medicine, and obtained his PhD after full time research in molecular endocrinology. He then trained in clinical genetics as a post-doctoral fellow of the Baylor College of Medicine, Tx, USA.

His research interests moved from molecular endocrinology to brain developmental disorders, in particular microcephaly, where he made several key discoveries and is currently a principal investigator funded by national and international research grants.

Marc Abramowicz has been the President of the Belgian Society of Human Genetics, and currently chairs the national College of Human genetics. He co-chairs the Genetic Evidence working group of the Global Genomic Medicine Collaborative of the NIH, USA.
